- (a) whether the Government has discontinued the periodic Census of Central Government Employees;**
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and**
- (c) if not, the year when the last census was undertaken and the time by which the next census is likely to be undertaken?**

**(a) to (b): No, Sir**

**(c) The last report on Census of Central Government Employees (as on 31.03.2011) was brought in 2014. The decision for bringing out of next report will be taken after obtaining views from Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) and National Statistics Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation.**

**(b): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. Government has taken various steps for generating employment in the country like encouraging private sector of economy, fast-tracking various projects involving substantial investment and increasing public expenditure on schemes such as Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Deendayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) run by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Ministry of Rural Development and Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, respectively. Employment generated through these schemes/programmes in country to the extent available is given below:**
