**3665. SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY:**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number and percentage of primary, middle, secondary and higher secondary schools in the country, State-wise especially in Bihar, district-wise, that have electricity, toilets and internet and the details thereof;
- (b) the total number of schools under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan in the country, with the strength of students in each school, State-wise;
- (c) whether there is a shortage of classrooms in many of these schools; and
- (d) the details of the number of Government and private schools in the country, with an average class size of more than 40 students, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) As per Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE) 2017-18, details of State/UT-wise number and percentage of primary, upper primary, secondary and higher secondary schools in the country, including Bihar, with electricity, toilets and internet facilities (6 to 12 class) are at Annexure-I. District-wise information is available on UDISE website [www.udise.in](http://www.udise.in).

(b) to (d) The Department of School Education and Literacy has launched an Integrated Scheme for School Education – Samagra Shiksha which subsumes three erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE) from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018. Samagra Shiksha focuses inter alia on improvement in school infrastructure in all States and Union Territories by providing support for various interventions like upgradation of schools, strengthening of infrastructure of existing schools and provision

of composite school grant to every school for providing a conducive learning environment.

State/UT-wise details of number of Government schools along with enrollment at Elementary level in the country are at Annexure-II. State/UT-wise details showing average Student Classroom Ratio (SCR) of Government schools & percentage of Government and Private schools with Student Classroom Ratio (SCR) more than 40 are at Annexure-III.
