# **Import of Medical Devices**

### 3858. SHRI P. RAVEENDRANATH KUMAR:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that approximately eighty per cent of the medical equipments used for critical care are being imported;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the total import of medical devices along with the implication of foreign exchange during the last three years;

(c) whether the Government has planned to establish multiple medical device parks across several States of the country to support medical technology innovation and manufacturing under Make in India initiative; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

## MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI D. V. SADANANDA GOWDA)

(a) & (b): The country is dependent on imports of medical devices to an extent of 85%. The total amount of foreign exchange incurred on imports of medical devices during the last three financial years is as under:

Financial Year	Import Value (USD MN)
2016-17	4406.9
2017-18	5009.5
2018-19	6204.0

(c) & (d): Department of Pharmaceuticals has a sub-scheme viz. Assistance to Medical Device Industry for Common Facility Center under the umbrella scheme for Development of Pharmaceuticals Industry. Under this sub-scheme, financial assistance to the tune of Rs.25 Crore or 70% of the project cost, whichever is less may be provided for creation of common facilities under any upcoming Medical Device Park promoted by State Governments/State Corporations. Department has received four proposals seeking financial assistance under this sub-scheme from the State Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Kerala and Tamil Nadu. The "inprinciple" approval has been given to proposals received from State Governments of Telangana, Kerala and Tamil Nadu while "final approval" has been given to the proposal received from Andhra Pradesh.
