Fishing Harbour in Nellore

3894. SHRI ADALA PRABHAKARA REDDY:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is some delay in setting up fishing harbour at Juvvala Dinnalo, Nellore District;

(b) if so, the reasons for the delay;

(c) whether the Ministry has commissioned a feasibility study of the project, if so, the reasons for not moving ahead; and

(d) the total amount of funds allocated for this project and the time by which it would be commissioned?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) : The Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted a proposal for construction of a fishing harbour at Juvvaladinne in Nellore District after completion of necessary feasibility studies, engineering and economic investigations and surveys. The Government of Andhra has estimated the cost for development of fishing harbour at Rs. 288.80 crore and sought 50% central finance assistance amounting to Rs.144.40 crore under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries. The Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) in the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has accordingly recommended the fishing harbour proposal for central financial assistance under the CSS. A time period of four years has been estimated for completion and commissioning of the fishing harbour at Juvvaladinne in Nellore District of Andhra Pradesh.
