Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether India is losing 2-4% of its GDP every year due to corrosion;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, industry-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has created a mechanism with the help of which this loss could be reduced;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): The impact of corrosion on GDP is not directly measured. However, MOSPI prepares the estimates of consumption of fixed capital (CFC) which also includes the effect of wear and tear, on capital goods. The industry wise CFC and CFC as percentage of GDP, for 2018-19 are given at annex.
