Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Indian High Commission in London has received a report from Tamil Nadu Police that 15th century bronze statue of Tamil poet 'Tirumankai Aalvar' which was reportedly stolen from a temple in Kumbakonam, Tamil Nadu and was replaced with a fake one and that the stolen idol is the same one that is with Ashmolean Museum in Oxford;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Indian High Commission, London on this report?

- (a) & (b) Yes. High Commission of India, London has received the report about the stolen idol of Tamil poet 'Tirumankai Aalvar' from Tamil Nadu Police.
