Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Haryana express train was not restored from Sirsa to New Delhi via Bhiwani, Rewari, Gurugram after gauge conversion before 25 years and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the Haryana express train is likely to be restored now to facilitate six districts of Haryana; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) Prior to gauge conversion. Haryana Express used to operate on the Delhi-Rewari-Bhiwani-Hisar route. Presently, 14085/86 Haryana Express is operating between Delhi and Sirsa via Rohtak-Bhiwani-Hisar section.

(b) and (c) Owing to operational constraints, at present, there is no proposal for operation of Haryana Express via Rewari-Bhiwani section. However, it has been decided to extend 74001/74004 Delhi-Rewari DEMU upto Hisar via Bhiwani.
