Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Governments proposes to start any new train from city railway station of district Udaipur of Rajasthan to Kanyakumari *via* Kota and Bengaluru;
- (b) if so, the time by which the said train is likely to be started; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF RAILWAYS AND COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a) to (c) Owing to operational constraints including terminal constraints at Kanyakumari, at present there is no proposal to introduce a new train between Udaipur and Kanyakumari. However, introduction of trains is an ongoing process on Indian Railways, subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, commercial validity, availability of resources, etc.
