- (a) & (b) An aggregate length of 578 km of National Highways has been constructed during last three years with an expenditure of Rs. 766.00 crore in the state of Gujarat.
- (c) The development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process. Ministry allocates funds state-wise and not NH wise. The work are accordingly taken up on NHs from time to time as per inter-se-priority, traffic density and availability of funds to keep road in traffic worthy conditions.
