**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has planned for infrastructure development in Kendriya Vidyalayas and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas for Khelo India event and Fit India movement;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the number of sports events organized under Khelo India so far along with locations thereof and the number of participants; and**
- (d) the status of upcoming expansion programme, critical review and targets set under Khelo India and availability of the resources therein?**

**(a) and (b) The Kendriya Vidyalayas and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas are under the aegis of the Ministry of Human Resource and Development and matters relating to planning and funding for their infrastructure development rests with that Ministry. No proposal for infrastructure development in Kendriya Vidyalayas and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas is under consideration in this Ministry.**

**Fit India Movement is a people centric movement in which citizens, including school children, are encouraged to take part voluntarily and include any form of physical activities in their daily routine.**

**The Khelo India Scheme aims to infuse sports culture, achieve sporting excellence in the country and encourage sports all over the country.**

**(c) A total of four national level competitions have been organized under 'Khelo India' so far. The details are at Annexure.**

**(d) The Khelo India Scheme in its present form was started in October, 2017 for a period of three years. So far Rs. 1320.79 crore has been spent and Rs. 71.44 crore is available for the remaining period of the current financial year. It would be a continuing scheme and the Government is making adequate funds available for the scheme. An amount of Rs. 890.42 crore is being allotted for the financial year 2020-21 for the Scheme.**
