URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION PROGRAMMES

NO. 4259. SHRI NATARAJAN P.R.:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of names of various programmes evolved for urban development and urban poverty alleviation till date;
- (b) the details of funds provision made, allocated/ utilised during each year of the past three years including current year particularly for poverty alleviation; and
- (c) the achievements made so far and the present status of these programmes?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS

(a): For urban development and urban poverty alleviation, programmes under implementation by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, include Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) (PMAY-U), Smart Cities Mission (SCM), Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and Swachh Bharat Mission- Urban (SBM-U).

- (b) Under DAY-NULM, the funds to the tune of Rs. 556.7 crore were released in 2017-18, Rs. 439.84 crore in 2018-19 and Rs. 647.78 crore in 2019-20 (so far). Further, the amounts utilised include Rs. 555.45 crore in 2017-18, Rs. 798.33 crore in 2018-19 and Rs. 617.32 crore in 2019-20 (so far). Utilization figures include the unspent balance of the previous years.
- (c) Under DAY-NULM, 4.5 lakh Self Help Groups have been formed; 10.6 lakh persons skill trained; 5 lakh beneficiaries assisted for setting up Individual/ Group micro enterprises; 15.5 lakh street vendors identified; and 1,367 shelters for urban homeless established.

Under PMAY(U), 1.04 crore houses have been sanctioned, 62.3 lakh houses grounded for construction and 32.3 lakh houses complete/ delivered, so far.

Under SCM, so far, an amount of Rs. 19,104 crore has been released to States/UTs out of which Rs. 11,181.61 crore has been utilised by the Smart Cities Mission.

Under AMRUT, so far, contracts have been awarded for 5,384 projects worth ₹73,641 crore including 2,529 completed projects worth ₹9,025 crore.

SBM has achieved the target of creating urban India Open Defecation Free. A total of 61.4 lakhs individual Household Toilets and 5.82 lakhs seats of community/ public toilets have been constructed. Till date, 1304 cities have been certified ODF+, and 481 have been certified ODF++.
