- (a) whether Detailed Project Report (DPR) for construction of National Highway-102B in the State of Manipur has been finalized;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the estimated cost of the project and the time frame set for completion of the project;
- (c) if not, the reasons for delay along with the present status thereof and the steps taken by the Government for expeditious finalization of the said DPR; and
- (d) the details of agencies involved in the process along with their roles and responsibilities?

- (b & c): The DPR for the entire length of 141.029 km of Churachanpur Tuvai on NH 102B in the State of Manipur has been completed at an estimated project cost of Rs.1390 Crore (approx.). Completion period for the road is 2 years from appointed date.
- (d): The Agencies involved with process are as under:
 - i) NHIDCL Preparation of DPR and implementation of project.
 - ii) State Govt. of Manipur -Land acquisition & Pre-Construction activities.
