(a) The digital mapping of the entire country has been completed in 2009 on 1:50K scale. This digital data can be freely accessed by Indian citizens on Survey of India's (SoI's) Public Portal i.e. <https://indiamaps.gov.in> and by Government agencies on <https://g2g.indiamaps.gov.in> using authorized access. The digital data/maps can also be purchased from Survey of India.

(b) & (c): Details of States in which the project has been started based on request received from the concerned State Government are as under:-

State	Area / Habitations covered	Scale	Funds allocated (in Rs.)	Remarks
Haryana	Entire Haryana State (44,212 Sq.km)	1:500 for urban areas and 1:800 for rural areas	150.00 Crore	Fund allocation varies due to different deliverables of the projects.
Maharashtra	Complete Abadi areas (40,000 Habitations)	1:500 scale	76.00 Crore	
Karnataka	Part of Karnataka State (51,000 Sq.km)	1:500 for both urban & rural areas	76.00 Crore	
Madhya Pradesh	Complete Rural / Urban habitations (number of habitations = 55,000)	1:500 for both urban & rural areas	40.10 Crore	

(d) Requisition from remaining States has not been received.

(e) The projects for Haryana, Maharashtra, Karnataka & Madhya Pradesh are targeted for completion by 2024.
