# PATIENTS OF SILICOSIS

## 4539. DR. MANOJ RAJORIA:

#### Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of patients of silicosis identified in the country, State/UT-wise;

(b) whether the Government provides any sort of financial assistance to such patients and also in case of deaths occurring due to silicosis disease;

(c) if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the silicosis disease happens predominantly to the labourers and workers engaged in mining professions and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the steps/measures taken/being taken by the Government towards creating awareness for its prevention and safeguards?

#### ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a): As per survey carried-out by the National Institute of Miners' Health, Nagpur, during the years 2015 to 2019, 391 cases of silicosis have been detected. State/UT wise details are annexed.

(b) & (c): Compensation for Silicosis affected persons is given under Employee Compensation Act, 1923, which is administered by Compensation Commissioners of respective states.

- (d): Any comparative data of silicosis between mining and other industries is not available.
- (e): Following measures have been taken to protect the mine workers:
  - i. Wet drilling.
  - ii. Periodic monitoring of dust levels at workplace.
- iii. Personal Dust Exposure profile using Personal Dust Samplers.
- iv. Use of Dust mask and Dust respirator as Personal Protective Equipments.
- v. Initial Medical Examination before employment and periodical Medical Examinations of persons employed in mines at an interval of 5 years.
- vi. Occupational Health Survey.
- vii. Awareness Campaigns.
