- (a) whether the Government has set any target to achieve the Skill India Mission;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the target achieved during the last three years, year wise;
- (c) whether the Government has allocated adequate funds for implementation of the Skill India Mission;
- (d) if so, the details of the funds allocated and spent and the number of youths trained during the said period;
- (e) whether new industrial training courses including electric vehicle courses are proposed to be introduced under the Skill India Mission; and
- (f) if so, give details?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI R.K. SINGH)

(a) to (f) Under the Skill India Mission, the Government has been implementing a number of skill development schemes/programmes across 22 Central Ministries/Departments for training over 40 crore people in India in different skills by 2022. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has been implementing Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY-2016-2020) and Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) for short term training. Details of persons trained / oriented along with funds allocated and spent are given below:-
