Jagdishpur-Haldia-Paradeep Gas Pipeline Project

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is proposing any scheme to supply gas through pipelines in all cities of the country, if so, the details thereof;

(b) the State-wise details of gas line projects proposed in the country;

(c) whether Jagdishpur-Haldia-Paradeep gas pipe line project is proposed, if so, the time by which the work is likely to be started on the said project;

(d) the reasons for the delay in the said project; and

(e) the names of the industries of Jharkhand and Bihar to which gas is likely to be supplied under the said project?

ANSWER

(a) Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) is the authority to grant authorization to the entities for the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) network in Geographical Areas (GAs) as per PNGRB Act, 2006. PNGRB identifies GAs for authorizing the development of CGD network in synchronization with the development of natural gas pipeline connectivity and natural gas availability. Providing PNG (domestic) connections and establishment of CNG Stations is a part of development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) Network by an authorized entity. So far PNGRB has authorized 230 GAs for development of CGD network across country up to 10th CGD Bidding Round covering more than 400 districts in the country in 27 States/UTs which covers around 71% of India's population and 53 % of area.

(b) Details of partly commissioned and under construction Natural Gas Pipeline in the country are at **Annexure.**

(c) to (e) Government has taken a decision to provide capital grant of Rs.5176 crore (i.e. 40% of the estimated capital cost of Rs.12,940 Crore) to GAIL for development of Jagdishpur-Haldia/Bokaro-Dhamra Gas Pipeline (JHBDPL) project. This pipeline will transport Natural Gas to the industrial, commercial, domestic and transport sectors in the States of Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh. Section-I of the JHBDPL Project has been completed. Project activities of the other sections of the JHBDPL project are at various stages of execution. It has been informed that there are issues relating to Right of Use (RoU) acquisition and obtaining forest clearance in certain section of the project.

This pipeline enables availability of eco-friendly cooking fuel/transportation fuel in the form of Piped Natural Gas (PNG) and Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) and also to provide natural gas to industrial/commercial consumers in the region. Major industries in the state of Jharkhand and Bihar which are likely to get gas through JHBDPL are Fertilizer Corporation of India Limited, Sindri; Steel Authority of India Limited, Bokaro; Central Coalfield Limited, Ranchi; Jindal Steel & Power, Ranchi; Hindustan Fertilizer Corporation Limited (HFCL), Barauni; Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Barauni and City Gas Distribution en-route of JHBDPL.
