Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Government has received any representations seeking construction of Road Over Bridges (ROBs) *in lieu* of Level Crossings in the State of Karnataka and if so, the details thereof along with the number of requests considered in the State;

(b) the number of ROBs constructed *in lieu* of Level Crossings during the last three years and till date;

(c) the details along with the works of ROBs completed, under construction and those proposals pending;

(d) whether the Government has set any timeframe to complete the construction of such ROBs; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 532 BY SHRI D.K. SURESH TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 05.02.2020 REGARDING ROBS IN KARNATAKA

(a): Railway have received proposals for construction of Road Over Bridges (ROBs) in lieu of level crossings on cost sharing basis in the State of Karnataka. Accordingly, the details of sanctioned ROBs in Karnataka during the last three years are as under:

(b) and (c): The number of ROBs constructed on cost sharing basis in the State of Karnataka during the last three years is as under:

2016-17	2017-18	2018-19	Total

As per Pink Book, 2019-20, 42 ROBs have been sanctioned on cost sharing basis in Karnataka. Out of these, 6 ROBs have been fully completed, railway portion of 7 ROBs has been completed and 29 are in various stages of planning, estimation and execution. No such valid proposals are pending with Railway.

(d) and (e): Normally, Railway undertakes construction of ROBs in Railway portion whereas approaches are being constructed by State Government. Generally, there is no problem of construction of ROBs in Railway portion. However, it is difficult to construct ROBs on approaches because it depends upon many factors such as availability of land, removal of encroachments, fixing the alignment of approaches, allocation of requisite funds etc. Therefore, it is not possible to fix the time schedule for construction of ROB projects.
