- (a) whether preparations to launch GSAT-30 satellite are going on;
- (b) if so, the likely benefits of the satellite; and
- (c) the time by which the services of the said satellite is likely to be received along with the details thereof?

## ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PG & PENSIONS AND IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) GSAT-30 satellite, with a lift-off mass of 3357 kg, was successfully launched from French Guiana onboard Ariane-5 launch vehicle on January 17, 2020.
- (b) GSAT-30 satellite is meant to provide continuity of services at 83°E location to 28 different users from both Government and non-Government category utilizing the capacity for DTH, TV Uplinking / Teleport, DSNG and VSAT applications.
- (c) It is planned to start operational services on GSAT-30 satellite from the first week of February, 2020 after completion of Inorbit Tests of communication payload.
