TERMINATION OF LICENCES

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to terminate licences of Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) in view of their failure to pay the dues to the Government to tune of Rs. 93,000 crore; and
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to ensure least disruption in services of TSPs post payment of aforesaid dues by these TSPs?
