### **Open Defecation**

#### †692. SHRI MAHABALI SINGH:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of households in Bihar where toilets have been constructed as on date since January 1, 2016;
- (b) the total number of community and public toilets constructed in the State during the said period; and
- (c) the number of urban and rural areas which have been declared as Open Defecation Free in the State?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF JAL SHAKTI (SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

- (a) and (b) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), 1,19,66,216 individual household latrines and 34 Community Sanitary Complexes have been constructed in Bihar since 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2016, as per the data reported by the State on the Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) maintained by the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation. And, under Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban), a total number of 3,87,178 individual household latrines and 16,293 Community Toilets and Public Toilets have been constructed in the State during this period.
- (c) All the 38,691 villages and the urban areas of all the 142 cities in Bihar have declared themselves Open Defecation Free.
