- (b) if so, the details of activities carried out under the scheme so far in all the cities; and**
- (c) the funds sanctioned for these projects and by when these projects would be completed?**

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b) : Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) scheme was launched on 25 June, 2015 for a period of five years i.e. up to 31 March, 2020 in selected 500 cities across the

country. The thrust areas of the Mission are water supply, sewerage & septage management, storm water drainage, non-motorized urban transport and green spaces & parks. The Mission also has reform agenda and capacity building programme.

The Mission is being implemented in 44 cities of the State of Maharashtra. The State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) worth Rs.7,759.32 crore including Central Assistance (CA) of Rs.3,534.08 crore have been approved for the State of Maharashtra. Any additional expenditure on the projects is to be borne by the State. Sector-wise implementation status of projects in the State is as under:
