SAI Training Centres

745. SHRI ANTO ANTONY:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any statistics regarding the number of training centres set up by Sports Authority of India (SAI) in the country during each of the last five years;**
- (b) if so, the details of such centres set up and the staff, including coaches and their assistants in the country, State-wise;**
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to enhance the number of SAI Centres in the country;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;**
- (e) whether the Government has any statistics regarding the funds allotted to SAI Centres in the country;**
- (f) if so, the details of funds given to SAI Centres during each of the last five years;**
- (g) whether the Government has received any complaints from any quarter regarding the misbehaviour of coaches and other trainers; and**
- (h) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?**

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The Sports infrastructure facilities available with Sports Authority of India (SAI) & Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) have sufficient capacity to cater to the training needs of a large number of athletes including high performance

training to elite athletes and hence no new Training Institute/ Training Centre has been established during last five years and no proposal is under consideration to open any new Training Institute.
