WORK ON NH-6 IN MAHARASHTRA

754. SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सडक परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of construction of National Highway-6 from Pimprala at Khamgaon to Chikhali Malkapur under Buldhana region in Maharashtra;
- (b) whether the work on the said NH has been held up and if so, the date since when the said construction work has remained closed alongwith the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government for timely completion of the said project?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) National Highway-6 from Pimprala at Khamgaon to Chikhali Malkapur under Buldhana region in Maharashtra is part of Amravati- Chikhli section. Earlier, 4-laning work of Amravati-Chikhli Stretch was implemented on BOT (Toll). Appointed Date of the project was declared on 9.11.2016. The Concessionaire achieved physical progress of 22% upto July 2018. Subsequently the work was stopped due to the financial crisis with the Concessionaire. Therefore, Concession Agreement was terminated on account of Concessionaire's default on 02.08.2019.

For completing the balance work of the project, the bids have been received and evaluation of bids has been initiated.
