(a): Yes, Sir. Airports Authority of India (AAI) in collaboration with NSDC is running 2(two) Aviation Multi Skill Development Centres (AMSDC) center under the Corporate Social Responsibility initiatives.

Airports Authority of India (AAI) have started 2 Multi Skill Development Centre in collaboration with National Skill Development Corporation(NSDC) and National Skill Development Fund (NSDF) at Chandigarh and Mumbai.

The centre in Chandigarh was inaugurated on 27th Feburary 2018. Over 2300

candidates are likely to be trained in Chandigarh in a span of 03 years. The centre in Mumbai started its first batch in April 2019. Over 700 candidates are likely to be trained in Mumbai in a span of 03 years.

Job roles identified for the aviation centre in Chandigarh & Mumbai are:-

(i) Airline Customer Service Executive

(ii) Airline Resrvation Agent

(iii) Airline Cargo Assistant

(iv) Airline Ramp executive

(v) Airline Flight Load Controller

(vi)Airline Security Executive

(vii) Airport X Ray qualified Staff

(viii) Airport Facility Services

(ix) Airline Baggage Handler

The training programmes aims at skilling as well as up-skilling in Aviation Sector. The industry will be benefited by acquiring skilled manpower at no additional training cost
