Tap Water Supply

819. SHRI MANOJ TIWARI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to supply tap drinking water to each household in the country in near future;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefore; and
- (c) the details of time-frame for any such proposal in near future for Delhi NCR?

(a) to (c) To enable every rural household with Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) across the country including NCT of Delhi, Government of India, in partnership with the States/UTs has launched Jal Jeevan Mission which aims at providing potable water at service level of 55 litre per capita per day (lpcd) by 2024. The estimated outlay planned for the Mission is of Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore out of which Central share is of Rs. 2.08 lakh Crore and the remaining as State share.
