- (a) the number of Anganwadi workers (AWWs) who have passed 10+2/below 10+2 level in Hazaribagh and Ramgarh districts of Jharkhand;
- (b) the detailed steps envisaged by the Ministry to impart training to AWWs for ensuring quality Early Childhood Care and Education?

- (a) Number of Anganwadi workers (AWWs) who have passed 10+2/ below 10+2 level in Hazaribagh and Ramgarh districts of Jharkhand is as under:

| District | 10+2 Passed (AWW) | Below 10+2 (AWWs) |
|-----------------|------------------------------|------------------------------|
| Hazaribagh | 879 | 876 |
| Ramgarh | 642 | 396 |

- (b) POSHAN Abhiyaan focuses on building the capacity of front-line ICDS functionaries in effective and consistent service delivery by using Incremental learning approach (ILA). Under ILA, functionaries are trained on thematic modules following the cascade of training of State Resource Group (SRG), District Resource Groups (DRGs) a Block Resource Groups (BRGs). Total 21 ILA modules have been provided to the States/UTs. The content focuses on the maternal, child health and nutrition umbrella as well as other nutrition interventions under the POSHAN Abhiyaan.
