1184. ADV. DEAN KURIAKOSE:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the tax evasion has increased after the implementation of Goods and Services Tax(GST);
- (b) if so, the details of evasion detected and the amount involved since 1st July 2017;
- (c) the details of FIR registered and arrest initiated in this regard, State wise;
- (d) whether the Government is also aware about the involvement of tax officials in the evasion cases;
- (e) if so, the details of such officers along with the action taken against them, State-wise; and
- (f) the details of measures taken by the Government to prevent/reduce GST evasion cases?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

- (a): No, Sir. There is no evidence to suggest that tax evasion has increased after the implementation of GST.
