- (a) whether the Government has received proposals from various States including Andhra Pradesh for the development and promotion of tourism and if so, the details thereof along with the allocation of funds; and**
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to promote tourism in the country?**

**(a) to (b): The Ministry of Tourism under its schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations/Central Agencies for development of tourism infrastructure in the country. Submission of project proposals by the State Government/UT Administrations and its sanctioning is a continuous process and the projects are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable Detailed Project Reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.**

**The details of the projects sanctioned under Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD scheme to different States including Andhra Pradesh is annexed.**

**The Ministry of Tourism undertakes various activities for the holistic promotion of India in Domestic and International Markets. As part of its on-going activities, the Ministry releases print, electronic, online and outdoor media campaigns in the international and domestic markets, to promote various tourism destinations and products of the country. The Ministry of Tourism during the financial year 2019-20 has extended financial assistance of Rs. 9.92 Crore to various States/UTs for organizing fairs & festivals and tourism related events.**

**In addition, the Ministry of Tourism has also undertaken following initiatives/programmes for promoting and encouraging tourism in the country:**

- (i) Launching of 'Adopt a Heritage: Apni Dharohar, Apni Pehchaan' project for developing tourism amenities at heritage/natural /tourist sites spread across India for making them tourists friendly in a planned and phases manner.**
- (ii) Identification of 19 Iconic Sites in the country for development by seeking convergence with other central Ministries/Departments /State Governments/ Urban & Local bodies.**
- (iii) Promoting India as a holistic tourism destination including its various tourism sites and products through Incredible India campaign 2.0.**
- (iv) Revamp of Incredible India website having information on tourism sites/destinations in different States / Union Territory Administrations.**
- (v) Launched Buddhist website - [indiathelandofbuddha.in](http://indiathelandofbuddha.in) to promote and showcase the rich Buddhist Heritage in India.**
- (vi) Co-ordination and encouragement of tourism stakeholders on issues related to development and promotion of tourism in the country.**
