Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that per capita income in the country has declined over the years;
- (b) if so, the details of per capita income during the last five years, year-wise and the likely per capita income in the current year after its decline;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the per capita income is constantly decreasing since demonetization in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) As per latest information available from National Statistical Office, the per capita income (i.e. per capita net national income at current prices) increased from Rs. 94,797/- in 2015-16 to Rs. 1,34,226/- in 2019-20. Per capita net national income at current prices since last five years is given in the table below.
