### **Students Forced into Employment Due to COVID-19**

#### 1287. SHRI V.K. SREEKANDAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that many children are at risk of not returning to school next year due to the economic fallout of COVID-19 and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether it is also true that the economic impact of COVID-19 could push more children into employment and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has any plan to prevent children drop out of school on account of the above reason; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) to (d) Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha, financial assistance is provided to the States and UTs for various activities to reduce number of dropouts, which include opening/strengthening of new schools upto senior secondary level, construction of school buildings & additional classrooms, setting up, up-gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas, setting up of residential schools/hostels, free uniforms, free text books, transport allowance and undertaking enrolment drives, residential as well as non residential trainings, Seasonal Hostels/ residential camps, etc. Financial assistance is also provided for Inclusive Education of children with special needs. Also, Mid-Day-Meal is provided to students at the elementary level of education.
