DEMAND AND SUPPLY OF SKILLED WORKER

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any scheme for bridging the gap between demand and supply of skilled workers in various fields is being implemented;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of persons trained as Yoga teachers and trainers under the Skill India Mission;
- (d) the State-wise details in this regard;
- (e) whether the Ministry has taken any step to fight against COVID-19 and has applied for any patent in its fight against the pandemic; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) and (b) Yes Sir. The Government is implementing various sector/ group specific schemes for bridging the gap between demand and supply of skilled workers. Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has been implementing the following schemes/programmes namely:

(i) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) to impart short term skill training to youth and recognition of prior learning of informally trained labour in National Skilled Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned qualifications through the involvement of private training partners.

(ii) 233 Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) to provide vocational training to non literates neo literates, school dropouts, etc by identifying the skills relevant in the local market.

(iii) Apprenticeship Scheme to make available industry ready workforce by training youth in the industry through apprenticeship. Government of India shares 25% of the

stipend paid to the apprentice, limited to Rs 1500/ pm per candidate for apprenticeship.

(iv) Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) to provide long term training in 137 trades through nearly 15000 Industrial Training Institutes.

Further, Ministry has launched 'Aatamanirbhar Skilled Employee Employer Mapping (ASEEM)' portal, which is a directory of all persons who have been formally skilled, and whose details are made available to the industry for meeting their skilled manpower needs anywhere in the country. This portal seeks to bridge the demand-supply gap in the skilled workforce market by providing real-time data about the demand and supply patterns including - industry requirements, demand per district/ state/cluster, key workforce suppliers, etc.

(c) and (d) Under Skill India Mission, as on 31.08.2020, 98,370 persons have been trained as Yoga Instructors and Trainers. State Wise details of candidates trained as Yoga Instructors and Yoga Trainers are placed at **Annexure**.

(e) and (f) The Ministry has taken a number of steps to help the nation to fight against Covid-19. Some of the major steps are as follow:-

- (i) The database of 1,75,000 persons trained by the Ministry's skilling ecosystem in health sector professionals such as Health Workers, Emergency Medical Technicians, General Duty Assistants, Home Health Aid etc were made available to the States for utilizing their services during the pandemic;
- (ii) The facilities in National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs)/Industrial Training Institutes (ITI) were made available to the States for use as Quarantine Centres / Isolation Wards
- (iii) About 32 lakhs of face mask were prepared and distributed by Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), ITIs and NSTIs.
- (iv) Skill levels of reverse migrant workers were mapped and process started to train 3 lakh such reverse migrants to ensure availability of local livelihood opportunities to these migrants
- (v) The data of willing overseas returnee migrants were captured and onboarded on ASEEM so as to provide job opportunities to them.
- (vi) Online Training was conducted through Bharat Skills portal covering 29 popular courses, e-learning video content for 71 courses and Question Bank for all the 137 trades under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) for ITIs benefitting 9,38,851 trainees;

As regards filing of patents is concerned, Government ITI Berhampur, Odisha has registered three of its innovative products for patent viz; (i) UVC (Ultraviolet C) Robo Warrior, (ii) Mobile Swab Collection Kiosk and (iii) Smart UVC Disinfection System.
