- (a) Government has decided to establish Indian Institute of Heritage and Conservation (IIHC) as part of the Budget Announcement of 2020-21. The Memorandum of Association, Bye Laws and Regulations for IIHC have been prepared. Necessary approvals are being obtained.
- (b) to (d) IIHC would conduct various Certificate, Diploma, Graduate, Post-Graduate, Doctoral, Post-Doctoral degree and Skill and Enterpreneurship Development Courses/Programs in the fields related to Heritage & Culture like Archaelogy, Conservation, Archives, Museology, Curation, Epigraphy and Manuscriptology.

Estimates for the establishment of IIHC, targets and timelines are being worked out.
