REVIVAL OF SIVAGIRI TOURISM CIRCUIT

- (a) whether the Government has approved the revival of Sivagiri Tourism Circuit project in Kerala;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the details of the plan prepared for implementation and the time by which the project is likely to be completed?

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism has approved revival of a Tourism project 'Development of Sivagiri Sree Narayana Guru Ashram – Arruvipuram – Kunnumpara Sree Subrahmania – Chembazhanthi Sree Narayana Gurukulam' for a sanctioned cost of Rs.69.47 Crore in June, 2020. India Tourism Development Corporation (ITDC) has been appointed as the implementing agency for this project. As per the initial sanction order issued to ITDC, the project should be completed and commissioned within a period of 24 months.
