ESI HOSPITAL AT VANIYAMBADI

1361. SHRI D.M. KATHIR ANAND:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has taken any steps towards upgrading the ESI hospital at Vaniyambadi in Tamil Nadu;
- (b)if so, the details of the fund allocated for the same; and
- (c)if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a): Presently the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) does not have any hospital in Vaniyambadi in the State of Tamil Nadu.

However, the ESI Corporation has given "In Principle" approval for setting up of a 100 bedded ESI hospital at Vaniyambadi.

(b) & (c): The District Administration, Tirupathur, Tamil Nadu has offered land to the extent of 2.02 acres for construction of the hospital at Vaniyambadi.

As regards fund allocation, it is done after approval of the estimate submitted by the construction agency to whom the work is allotted.
