EMPLOYMENT IN RURAL AREAS

1402. SHRI RAJAN VICHARE:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has any scheme to provide jobs at panchayat level;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of persons provided jobs under the Poor Welfare Employment campaign so far during the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- (d) the length (in Kilometres) of roads constructed so far under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana last year along with the details thereof, State-wise?

(a)&(b): The Ministry is implementing the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), through States/UTs which assure upto 100 days of wage employment in a financial year to every rural household whose adult member volunteers to do unskilled manual work. Gram panchayat is the implementing agency under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme at panchayat level. Under the scheme, during the current financial year 203 crore persondays have been generated from April 2020- 17 September 2020.

(c): there is no "Poor Welfare employment campaign" being run by the Ministry. However under Garib Kalayan Rojgar Abhayan (GKRA), launched on 20 June 2020, a total of about 28 Crore Mandays Employment has been generated so far under GKRA in 116 districts selected for the Abhiyan in 6 States.

(d): The State-wise details of length (in Kilometres) of roads constructed so far under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana during last year 2019-20, are given at Annexure.
