#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & DAIRYING (DR. SANJEEV KUMAR BALYAN)

(a) The National Dairy Plan Phase I (NDP I), a Central Sector Scheme of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India was implemented by the National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) with a network of End Implementing Agencies (EIAs) during the period between 2011-12 and 2018-19 with a total outlay of Rs. 2,242 crore. NDP I had following objectives:

- i) Increase productivity of milch animals and thereby increase milk production to meet the rapidly growing demand for milk.
- ii) Provide rural milk producers with greater access to the organized milk processing sector.

NDP I was implemented in 18 major milk producing States including Jharkhand, where in a total of 577 sub projects of 172 EIAs were approved with total approved grant assistance of Rs. 1,759.97 Crore. The implementation of NDP I ended on 29 November 2019 and the financial closure was completed on March, 2020. (b) Under NDP I, approved sub projects were implemented through eligible EIAs in their operational areas which included some of the aspirational districts. Out of the total 115 aspirational districts, 34 aspirational districts across 14 States were covered by the EIAs under NDP I, implementing sub projects with grant assistance of about Rs. 96 Crore. Jharkhand Milk Federation implemented sub project of Village Based Milk Procurement system (VBMPS) and Ration Balancing Program (RBP) under NDP I. The operational area of the project included Hazaribagh and Ramgarh districts. The list of approved sub projects is mentioned in the table below:
