CONVERGENCE OF CENTRAL & STATE GOVERNMENT SCHEMES

- (a) whether the Central and State Governments' schemes at the implementation level can be converged with the help of technology so that continuous monitoring can be done with the help of dash boards;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Ministry has considered working in collaboration with district Governments through capacity building of personnel at the local level and at the national level;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) launched District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committees (DISHA) Dashboard on 11th October 2017 as a single source of information in respect of schemes run by various Ministries which aims to create a data driven governance solution for planning, monitoring and evaluating multiple parameters of various schemes under DISHA monitoring system. As on date, 36 schemes of different Ministries have been integrated through Application Programming Interface (APIs) for real time data display, on the DISHA Dashboard. Status of Schemes integrated on DISHA Dashboard as on date is at **Annexure-I**

The Ministry, with the support of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) has designed, developed and implemented various IT driven solutions for its flagship programmes. A snapshot of the IT solutions that support the implementation and monitoring of rural development programmes, promote transparency and accountability is detailed at **Annexure-II**.

(c) & (d): With a view to attaining the the collaboration of the States/ UTs and Districts with respect to the various schemes of MoRD, the Ministry has been organizing periodic training/ workshops/ seminars with Officers/ Officials from States/ UTs including District/ Block/ GP level Officials for capacity building of personnel at the local and national level.
