- (a) & (b): The Government has not signed any Defence Agreement with France and other countries to ensure security at the border of India in the last three years.
- (c) Many significant projects including 155mm Artillery Gun, Light Combat Aircraft :Tejasø, :Akashø Surface to Air Missile System, Submarines etc, have been produced in India as part of defence production in the country.
- (d) No, Sir.
- (e) & (f): In pursuance to the budget announcement (2018-19), it has been decided to set up two Defence Industrial Corridors in the country, one in Uttar Pradesh and another in Tamil Nadu.
