### CONCERNS OF EMPLOYEES OF ITI LIMITED

#### 1670. SHRI V.K.SREEKANDAN:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether employees of ITI Limited at Palakkad were not getting salary on time;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has received any representation in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government thereon?

### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS, EDUCATION AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE)

- (a) Salary payment to ITI units including Palakkad Unit is done every month with an average delay of 3 weeks approximately.
- (b) The delay is due to stress on cash flows.
- (c) & (d) A VIP reference dated 08.08.2020 from Shri V.K. Sreekandan, Hon'ble M.P. (Lok Sabha) was received in Department of Telecommunications (DoT HQ), which inter alia referred to non-payment of salary for the month of June & July, 2020 to employees of ITI Palakkad Unit. This was taken up with ITI Ltd., who informed that the salary of June, 2020 & July, 2020 was delayed due to Covid-19 Lockdown and it was paid on 05.08.2020 and 21.08.2020 respectively.
