- (a) whether there are specific plans for States like Odisha which is having low Tele-density to improve connectivity in the State and if so, details thereof;
- (b) the number of Gram Panchayats in undivided Koraput District of Odisha where there is no mobile connectivity;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to provide mobile connectivity in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government is having any plan to improve quality of data connectivity in rural areas and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the plan proposed by the Government to increase data connectivity in Left-Wing Extremism affected areas?
