- (a) District-wise number of Individual household latrines (IHHLs) constructed under Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) [SBM(G)] in Rajasthan from 2.10.2014 to 18.9.2020, as per the data reported by the State on the online integrated management information system, are given at **Annexure-1**.
- (b) Details of funds released and utilised in the State of Rajasthan under SBM(G) during the last three years are as under:
