- (a) to (b): In the preparatory phase of Krishi Udaan Scheme, between 1 April 2020 and 31 August 2020 as per estimates more than 65,000 metric tonnes of agriproduce was air freighted, of which about 75 per cent was export cargo. Almost every Indian scheduled airline operators including Air India, Air India Express, Air Asia, Blue Dart Aviation, Go Airlines, IndiGo, Spice Jet, and Vistara participated in airlifting agri-produce either in belly holds, in cargo-on-seat passenger charters, or in dedicated freighter operations. The principal airports which participated included Agartala, Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Cochin, Coimbatore, Delhi, Guwahati, Imphal, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mangalore, Mumbai, Surat, Trichy, and Vishakhapatnam. Agri-produce uplifted included Mango, Litchi, Cherry, Banana, Rasakdali, Banana Leaves, Pineapple, Custard Apple, Apple, Peas, Babycorn, Coriander, Cucumber, Cluster Beans, Drumstick, Small Onion, Curry Leaves, Betel Leaves, Green Vegetables, Flowers, Walnuts, Shrimps, Meat and Meat Products, Paneer, Tea, Spices, Rice, etc. Airport, airline and sector-wise data is not maintained.
- (c): The Krishi Udaan Scheme has been approved and circulated to all concerned Ministries/ Departments on 10 September 2020 for implementation. The operation of the Krishi Ûdaan Scheme is not limited to the pandemic period.
