#### **GUIDELINES FOR TRANSPORT DURING LOCKDOWN**

- (a) and (b) No such proposal is under consideration.
- (c) and (d) During the process of Lockdown various orders and guidelines were issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs. The guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs allowed the inter State movement of all goods and cargo. The Ministry of Home Affairs and the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways were continuously monitoring such movement of goods / cargo and provided all assistance for the smooth movement across States / UTs.

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
