WORK ON NHS AND EXPRESSWAYS

1931. SHRI THIRUNAVUKKARASAR SU:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of construction of various National Highways (NHs) and expressways in the country and the estimated cost thereof, project and State-wise particularly in Tamil Nadu;**
- (b) the extent to which these projects are likely to reduce the travel time, fuel cost and distance, project wise;**
- (c) whether there is any delay in completion of the said projects and if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and**
- (d) the time by which the said projects are likely to be completed?**

- (a) Details of ongoing works of National Highways including expressways at present in the country, State-wise including Tamil Nadu are at Annexure-I.**

(b) These projects shall optimize the efficiency of freight and passenger movement across the country by bridging critical infrastructure gaps. These roads include development of Economic Corridors, Inter Corridor and Feeder Corridor, National Corridor Efficiency Improvement, Border and International connectivity roads, Coastal and Port connectivity roads and Green-field expressways. These roads run through the length and breadth of the country, connect adjacent countries, the National Capital with State Capital and the State Capitals mutually, major ports, non-major ports, large industrial centers or tourist centers, meet very important strategic requirement in hilly and isolated areas, help opening up large tracts of backward area and hilly regions (other than strategically important ones) which enable sizeable reduction in travel time & distance.

(c) & (d). There are 778 delayed projects (National Highways including expressways) under this ministry. Details of these projects are given at Annexure-II. These projects are delayed mainly due to land acquisition, utility shifting, non-availability of soil/aggregate, poor performance of contractors, environment/forest/wildlife clearances, ROB & RUB issues with Railways, public agitation for additional facilities, arbitration/contractual disputes with contractors etc. These projects are given time period of 2 to 3 years for completion.
