Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has fixed norms for National Youth Award; and
- (b) the facilities being provided by the Government to the National Youth Award winners?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

- (a) Yes, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports confers National Youth Award for identifiable excellent work for youth in different fields of development activities and social service such as health, research and innovation, culture, promotion of human rights, art and literature, tourism, traditional medicine, active citizenship, community service, sports and academic excellence & smart learning. 25 awards and 10 awards are given in individual and organization category respectively.
- (b) Award to individuals comprises a medal, a certificate and an award money of Rs. 1,00,000/- whereas the Award to voluntary youth organizations comprises a medal, a certificate and an award money of Rs. 3,00,000/-.
