(a) & (b) Fifteen National Highway projects funded by the Union Government are pending/delayed in the State of Tamil Nadu including Ramanathapuram District. The main reasons for the delay in completion of these National Highway projects are delay in land acquisition, removal of encroachments, Forest/Environmental issues, Non-grant/delay of quarry permission, restrictions imposed by State Administration for conveyance of construction materials, pending court case etc. Periodic review/meetings at higher level from time to time and constant follow up with State Administration and other agencies for expediting land acquisition and other preconstruction activities are being taken to expedite completion of these projects.
