Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the criteria fixed by the Government for participating in Vendor Development Programmes (VDPs);
- (b) whether the Government has achieved the objectives for which VDPs has been organized, if so, the details thereof and if not, the corrective steps taken in this regard;
- (c) the details of VDPs conducted by Government at National and State level along with the outcome thereof during each of the last three years;
- (d) the details of the vendors registered by the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) in acumulative way during the said period;
- (e) the details of the initiative taken by the leading PSUs in the country under the VDPs; and
- (f) the other steps taken by the Government to provide business opportunities to Micro and Small Enterprises to expand their market base?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI PRATAP CHANDRA SARANGI)

- (a): Any registered Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) can participate in Vendor Development Programmes. The Vendor Development Programs (VDPs) are aimed at building the capacity of MSEs and enhancing their participation in public procurement process.
- (b): Yes Sir, the procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) by Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) increased from 23.11% in 2017-18, 26.32% in 2018-19 to 30.95% in 2019-20 and 32.97% in 2020-21 (till 17th September,2020).
- (c) & (d): The details of Vendor Development Programmes organized by Ministry of MSME and the vendors registered with Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) as on 17th September, 2020 are given below.
