VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

2121. SHRI DUSHYANT SINGH: SHRI P.P. CHAUDHARY:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is in an increase in number of cases of domestic violence against women reported between March 22nd 2020 and July 31st 2020 as compared to previous months of the same year;
- (b) if so, the details of the cases registered on the basis of said reports along with the number of cases registered during the previous six years, State-wise;
- (c) the number and the date of cases registered for domestic violence and the date of disposal of such cases prior to March 22nd 2020, State-wise;
- (d) the quantum of funds allocated/ utilized under Mahila police Volunteer scheme, States-wise;
- (e) the number of One Stop Centres established, State-wise; and
- (f) the total number of beneficiaries under the scheme and their distribution based on the type of assistance given to them?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (f): National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) compiles and publishes information on crimes in its publication "Crime in India". The published reports are available till the year 2018. State-wise and year-wise total number of cases of domestic violence during the previous six years is available on the website of National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB), https://ncrb.gov.in.

From the beginning of lockdown due to Covid 19 pandemic, the National Commission for Women (NCW) launched an Ad campaign through electronic media and social media inviting women who have suffered any kind of violence to come forward and report it. Further, in addition to handling complaints received through regular modes, NCW has also launched a WhatsApp number 7217735372 on 10.04.2020 for reporting domestic violence cases. The additional modes provided by NCW facilitated reporting of cases, including from women who had been experiencing violence at home for past several years. The complaints received by NCW are acted upon by coordinating with victims, police and other authorities to provide necessary assistance. Further under the One Stop Centre and Women Helpline Schemes of this Ministry more than 54 lakh violence affected women and women in distress have been assisted since launch of these schemes in 2015.

The States-wise quantum of funds allocated/ utilized under Mahila Police Volunteer scheme is at **Annexure-I**

The Government has operationalised 684 One Stop Centres for violence affected women. The State-wise number of operationalised One Stop Centres and the total number of women assisted by One Stop Centres is at **Annexure-II**.
