- (a) the time by which the training programme on 'Track Child Portal' under the child safety plan is likely to be organised;
- (b) the details including names of such places where the above training programmes have been conducted during the last three years;

- (e) the outcome of said training along with the details thereof?

(a) to (e): The Ministry of Women and Child Development has developed a web portal "TrackChild" to track the missing and found children. The TrackChild Portal is implemented with the help of various stakeholders including Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Railways, State Governments/UT Administrations, Child Welfare Committees, Juvenile Justice Boards, National Legal Services Authority, etc. National Informatics Centre organises regular training programmes on Trackchild portal as per the requirement of the States/UTs.
