Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken/proposed by the Government to set up a branch of National Research Centre on Camels (NRCC) in Gujarat, so far;
- (b) the steps taken/proposed to protect Kharai camels; and
- (c) the steps taken/proposed by National Research Centre on Camels to protect double humped camel in Ladakh?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

- (a) For setting up of a branch of National Research Centre on Camel (NRCC), Bikaner, an appropriate size of land and other resources on nominal cost/lease basis is desired from the Government of Gujarat.
- Kharai camel has been characterized, registered and gazette notified as breed by DARE/ICAR.

- 2. NRCC has signed an MoU with Kamdhenu University, Gujarat for further breed conservation and development by (i) Training of farmers for scientific camel husbandry; (ii) Organizing Scientist-farmers interaction meetings; (iii) Holding animal health camps; (iv) Providing technical support for development of the entrepreneurship towards the camel milk.
- (c) Following is being carried out by NRCC, Bikaner to protect double humped camel in Ladakh:-
 - 1. Camel health management by organizing health camps in Nubra valley.
 - 2. Nutritional management by utilizing local feed resources.
